

APPROACH TO SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

1. We will run a sustainable and responsible business:

- In order to do so, we will push for improvements to environmental standards in our designs and in our installation techniques.
- We will focus on working on schemes that seek to deliver quality buildings (and installations) and seek to influence those stakeholders that we can reach (clients, fellow tradesmen).
- We will look to drive continuous improvement within our own business and act as an example of excellence to our peers and supply chain.
- We will focus on the whole-life cost of the products that we design, purchase and install, factoring-in environmental and maintainability issues.

2. We will do our part to tackle climate change and improve our energy efficiency:

 - avoiding unnecessary travel, optimising local resources and travelling "green" where practicable; and
